INVESTING IN TRUE FRIENDSHIP



PRECEPT -

JOHN 15:12-14

¹² My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. ¹³ Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. ¹⁴ You are my friends if you do what I command.

PROVERBS 13:20

²⁰ Walk with the wise and become wise; associate with fools and get in trouble.

PROMISE -

Do you have friends whom you can call in times of need? Friends whom you can call in times of emergency? Friends to whom you can cry on? You are indeed very blessed if you have these kinds of friends. Sadly, there are people out there without these kinds of friends. Those are the people God called us to invest more, to help them find true friendship.

As we experience the friendship Jesus offers us, let us offer this same love and camaraderie to other people around us. When we are prioritizing this friendship, we will naturally draw others to the Father as well. Jesus uses the word philos for friend, meaning "friend, associate, familiarly with one, companion, one of the bridegroom's friends." Philos is how we would identify those people we would select to be our bridesmaids and groomsmen, those who have been with us through thick and thin, and those who will support us in our big life decisions. Let's bring these people closer to God and love them by the example of Christ. John 15:12-13 tells us, "12 My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. 13 Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends." We must not be content with fewer friends and seasonal friendships. Once we get too comfortable with a few core and close friends, we can lose the ability to see our neighbour who is lonely or a co-worker or class mate who is struggling in life. Here are some practical steps for us to invest in making friends with others.

INVEST MORE IN TRUE FRIENDSHIP: CONNECT AND CREATE

One of the ways that we can connect to our friends is by remembering special events in their lives. The simple gestures of greeting them during their birthday, anniversary, promotion, work or school achievements can mean a lot to them. Engage also in deeper conversations that can touch their hearts and make them feel loved. Create new memories and experience life together. Find adventures and take initiatives to plan trips together. True friendship is built and strengthened by meaningful experiences and unforgettable memories. Create an environment for each other that provides support and encouragement and try to speak their love language. Listen to them without judgement and offer practical help in times of need. Make your friendship an avenue to bring out the best in them.

Let us intentionally build relationships with others for the purpose of becoming more like Christ. We must also make it out mission to influence others to the likeness of Christ and to love Him with all our hearts and all our might. We are not able to tell others about Him if we remain in our selected social circles, never meeting new people who need to know him. Let us work to make space for people who do not yet know Jesus, and be intentional in how we spend our time with them. As we go and make this happen, Jesus, who is our friend, is our help and guide. This brings comfort when we live out our command to go and tell others about Him.
