THE CRUCIFIXION

PRECEPT -

2 Corinthians 4:18

¹⁸ We don't look at the troubles we can see now; rather, we fix our gaze on things that cannot be seen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.

PROMISE

Did you know that God promised to be with us and help us was mentioned in the bible? The problem with us is that despite God communicating His promises and plan, we tend to neglect His promises, and when we are struggling with life, we tend to reject God's promises.
