

REDISCOVERING OUR PURPOSE

PRECEPT

Ephesians 3:20

²⁰ Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us.

PROMISE

When you lose hope, you don't just lose motivation; you lose direction. Purposeless thinking, you know the feeling that you're alive, but you're not expecting anything. You show up, but deep down, you're just getting through the days. Paul said in Ephesians, "Him who is able..." and he starts by shifting our focus, not to our own strength or past mistakes, but to God, who is able. Our future is not limited by what we can do; it is held by what God can do, which is limitless. God's plans were never limited by our imagination.

When God feels silent, don't quit—believe that He is still working in you. When God feels quiet, don't stop seeking purpose. God is working in you before He works through you. When life feels delayed, don't lose hope—believe God is preparing you. Instead of asking, "Why am I still here?" Ask, "God, what are You building in me right now?" Your purpose isn't late, you're being prepared. When you feel unqualified, remember God's power is working within you. Purpose doesn't begin with confidence; it begins with trust. God grows us as we obey, not before. Our purpose is not about our ability—it's about God's power at work within us. You don't need to feel strong or qualified to believe that He is at work. When you discover your purpose, live it as a blessing to others. God's work in you is never just for you. This year, don't just ask, "God, what do You want to do for me?" Ask, "God, who do You want to bless through me?" If we truly lived like this—trusting God's work, believing His power, and walking in purpose—imagine what this year could look like.

Imagine what this year would look like if you actually believed that God can do more than you can ask or imagine, and that He's already at work within you. Not a perfect year, not a problem-free year, but a different kind of year. Our year is not driven by fear, comparison, or exhaustion, but by trust because when God works within us, he begins to work through us. Rediscover your purpose—not in what you can do, but in what God is already doing in you and through you.

PRACTICE

- 1. Reset.** What purpose is God inviting you into this year?
- 2. Purpose Driven.** In what area of your life do you need to trust God's plan over your own? And how can we pray/encourage you regarding this?
